SUBJECT: Integration of CTCRM October 2021 Edition to TACT Online

Dear CTC and TACT members,

The Cargo Tariff Coordinating Conferences Resolutions Manual (CTCRM) provides a central reference to the texts of all current resolutions adopted by the Cargo Tariff Coordinating Conferences. The Manual also contains the texts of government reservations which have been placed on resolutions.

Following a review undertaken by the CTC task force we have identified several important changes and enhancements to the CTCRM which we believe will improve operational integration in the air cargo industry.

[TACT Online](#) is a platform providing Air Cargo Tariffs, Rules, as well as Air Cargo Schedules & other Cargo Modules to the air cargo industry. It is historically the medium of reference used by thousands of users every day and is powered by hundreds of sources.

While TACT Tariffs can be integrated into our customers operational systems, our Rules & Regulations are not yet. Our customers do not have a single access point to all the relevant Rules & Regulations that IATA provides to the industry and are required to purchase them via separate channels depending on the product.

With this in mind, it has been agreed to leverage [TACT Online](#) for the distribution of the CTCRM, ensuring we continue to serve IATA customers in a simple, timely and effective way.

By integrating the CTCRM within [TACT Online](#), customers will benefit from one comprehensive source for all cargo tariffs which will save time while assuring customers do not lose revenue due to poor tariffing and timely resolutions updates. The next edition of the CTCRM (October 2021) will be incorporated into [TACT Online](#) as the main channel of IATA Cargo Tariffs related communication to the industry.
