014b	Combination Rules for Cargo Rates - Government Reservations - Canada	<p>Existing text: Acceptance of tariffs reflecting Resolution 014b shall be subject to the tariff filing requirements of the Canadian Transportation Agency and nothing shall be construed as limiting in any way the power of the Canadian Transportation Agency to permit or require tariff revisions on 30 days notice, or less as approved, in accordance with its tariff filing requirements.</p> <p>New text: Acceptance of tariffs reflecting Resolution 014b shall be published and filed with the Canadian Transportation Agency, or its authorized filing agent, IATA TACT.</p>
