You have just unpacked the TACT June 2021 Edition, containing **the last edition of the TACT North America and Worldwide Tariff manuals.**

TACT Air Cargo Solutions have included the TACT Tariffs + Rules Manuals (Rules, North America Rates and Worldwide Rates volumes) since its inception and now for over 7 decades. Many in our industry have started their cargo careers with the TACT Manuals in hand as a valuable starting point and an important resource ever since.

The air cargo industry is evolving, becoming more complex, connected and integrated.

To effectively manage the increasing pace and rate of change, TACT Air Cargo Solutions have supported this transition for many years, giving customers a choice of different digital product options.

Our customers recognise the benefits of using online and integrated TACT products, as over 80% of customers have adopted such solutions today.

While the TACT Tariff Manuals have been a standard reference for the industry, the nature of a paper-based product no longer makes it a suitable option in the rapidly changing cargo world, increased digital operations and CO2 efficient solutions. Recognising the environmental impact of creating and distributing globally the TACT Tariff manuals, IATA has made the decision to stop the production of the TACT Tariff Manuals (North America and Worldwide) as of the **October 2021 Edition.**

In October 2021 you will receive the TACT Rules Manual, but no longer the Tariff Manuals.
